Individual Reflections

Reflections are designed to help guide your thinking and to help you prepare for scheduled activities during the semester. These reflections are to be completed on the weeks indicated and recorded in your **My Journal**. They are checked by the TAs and/or advisors during **My Journal** grading.

1. Project Partner Meeting: Preparation and reflection

Before the Project Partner Meeting: Before you meet with your project partner, evaluate your current projects and resources and develop a semester plan. Prepare questions to ask your project partner regarding the project and/or needs of the project partner prior to the meeting. Write them in your **My Journal**. Look ahead to the reflection questions so that you can be prepared to answer them after your project partner meeting.

During the Project Partner Meeting: You should discuss your semester plan with your project partner. Ask questions regarding projects/community partner needs/etc. Write responses in your **My Journal**. Address any questions/concerns that your project partner may have regarding the project.

Reflection on Project Partner Meeting: After the meeting, write responses to the following questions in your **My Journal**:

1. Summarize your project partner's mission in the community (i.e., What community issue is your project partner attempting to address?)
2. Summarize the task(s) that your team will be working on this semester that were agreed upon by project partner and team. How do these tasks relate to or advance the mission of your project partner?
3. What expertise does your project partner bring to these projects?
4. Describe your participation at this meeting.

2. Design Process: preparation for the semester plan presentation

Individual students should answer the following Design Process Reflection questions in their **My Journal** as preparation for the week 4 semester plan presentation:

1. Where in the design process is the project?
2. What stages of the design process have been completed and properly documented for the project?
3. What stages of the design process are planned to be completed this semester and what work is needed to achieve this plan?
