The Hammering with Hope house will be built in several stages. October 13th– 16th, Purdue Habitat will be partnering with the BCM (Building Construction Management) department to construct the frame of the house in the lot between PEFCU and the Visitor Parking Garage on Northwestern. On Sunday, October 17th we will be marching from this location to the Lafayette Habitat Office carrying tools and materials to raise awareness. The frame will then be disassembled and taken to its permanent location. From then, it will take approximately 12 weeks to complete the house.
