1. You **must always** show your passport or Driver's License or State ID when you want to sit at a bar. The Greek driver's license usually is not accepted.
2. You **must** be at least 21 to be served any alcoholic beverage.

Drink regulations differ from state to state, so make sure that you know the rules when it comes to drinking.

## *Indiana Driver's License*

---

Do you need to get a driver's license? Here's how you do it:

- If you don't have an international license you will need a validated translation of your Greek license. Ask us for a template. The translation can be validated by any Greek faculty member at Purdue.
- One proof of ID (eg. unexpired passport, or birth certificate, or unexpired Indiana ID, etc.).
- One proof of lawful status (eg. I-94)
- Social security number (eg. social security card, or W-2 form, etc.).
- Two proofs of residency (eg. utility company, credit card, doctor/hospital bill issued within 60 days of application)
- If you are a student, you also need your I-20 (F1 visa) or your DS-2019 (J1 visa).
