D2 NCAA Tourney: Lost to Alaska-Anchorage in Elite Eight  
Returning Starters: 2

Not a whole lot of information on these guys other than their stats from last year and their first game of the season against Miami (OH) this year.

Bill Brown (Coach)- Top assistant to Eddie Sutton at Arkansas. Has been head coach for 24 years.

### Projected Starters:

#5 Kelsey Williams (So, 6-7, 220)- Preseason 1st team all conference. Led team with 12 PPG and 5.9 RPG last year. He's not an outside shooting threat, and they don't play anyone over 6'8" so we could see JJ on him, but more likely it will be Hummel guarding him most of the time.

#20 Jerrial Nixon (Sr, 6-1, 215)- Second in scoring at 11 PPG, best 3 point shooter on team. Led the team in scoring against Miami (OH) on Sunday, but he has likely never faced defense like he will against Kramer and Co. Good distributor, but also gives the ball up a lot

#21 Chris Moore (Sr, 6-8, 185)- Good shot blocker, but turns the ball over a lot. Has the body of a twig, so this should be an easy one for JJ to match up with.

#10 Travis Williams (Jr, 6-0, 195)- Gets a lot of rebounds for being a little guard, also creates some steals

#15 Andrew Young (Fr, 6-8, 230)- This is as big as they get. He was productive in his first collegiate game scoring 11 points.

#24 Travon Vann (So, 6-4, 195)- Didn't make a shot from the field in the first game, he managed to get his way to the foul line a few times though.
