In regards to the grievance filed, the Purdue Student Supreme Court has found the McMains/Kraft ticket in violation of the Election Rules of the Purdue Student Government, where as in, Article VIII., Section 8.01, Part B, Subpoint (d):

“Improper use of university or other unauthorized facilities.”

Purdue Student Supreme Court unanimously decided (5-0), that the grievance submitted was an infraction. According to the Election Rules of the Purdue Student Government, where as in, Article VI, Section 6.03, Part D, Subpoint (b):

“Any type of campaigning that violates the University Regulations regarding publicity.”

Whereas in University Regulations, Part 6, Section V, Part C:

“Posters and signs may be displayed in specified areas within buildings and on the campus, provided that clearance has been obtained from the appropriate people in the following offices...”

Whereas in University Regulations, Part 6, Section V, Part C, Subpoint 3:

“In all other buildings, the building deputy or director whose office is located in that building.”
