New Purdue Student Government chief justice sworn in

WEST LAFAYETTE, Ind. – Jan. 15, 2009 – Interim Chief Justice Derek Michtich was sworn in as the new chief justice of Purdue Student Government at Wednesday evening’s senate meeting.

Chief Justice Michtich has been involved in with PSG since his freshman year when he was appointed as an investigator. He is now a senior majoring in accounting and management with a minor in finance.

“We’re working on a ‘Know Your Rights’ program and hoping to enhance the relationship between the student body and the Purdue police,” said Michtich. “We’re also hoping to have a ‘Know Your Rights Week’ at some point this semester.”

Other new business included a first reading of Bill 8-11, “A revision of the constitution of the Purdue Student Government,” which proposes to amend the constitution as submitted. The bill will be read for a second time and voted upon at the next senate meeting.

Members present at the meeting and in favor of the proposed renovation project for the Recreational Sports Center wrote letters to state senators and representatives asking for their support for the project.

The next general senate meeting is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on Jan. 28, 2009.
