ALL rooms are furnished with a bed, chair, and desk for each occupant. Rooms are air-conditioned. Every floor has two corridor baths. Elevator service is provided to all floor - no steps to climb. You will have a prepared room and bed made with linen and will be provided with 1 towel, and 1 washcloth upon arrival. Local telephone service is available. Rooms are not equipped with televisions. There is no provision for wake-up service. Luggage carts are available for your use.. Hawkins Hall facilities are designed for adult conference participants. Children are not permitted. Accommodations for families/children are available at the Purdue Memorial Union Club. The hall is located within a block of the Purdue Memorial Union and Stewart Center. A limited number of rooms equipped to accommodate those with disabilities are available.

- Parking is available at Hawkins Hall. Permits for garage parking may be purchased at the Hawkins Hall Main Office for \$1.00/day. Attendee parking is also available at the Grant Street garage for \$2.00/hour or a maximum of \$10.00/day.

Bills are payable to Purdue University at check-in. Please do not send a pre-payment. Check-in is at Hawkins Hall on Thursday, June 5, 2008. Check-out is on Saturday, June 7, 2008. Visa, Master Card, Discover/NOVUS, cash, or personal checks are accepted.

Deadline for reservations is Friday, May 23, 2008. Housing reservations will be confirmed two weeks prior to the conference. The number of rooms and room types may be limited and will be assigned in the order the applications are received.
