

The Midterm exam (March 28, 2007) will be given during class time and in the classroom. It will last 50 minutes. So come to class on time!

The exam will consist of 3 parts.

Part I: Identification (30 points)

This section will cover all the six novels we have read so far. In this section, I will give you a passage from each of the books and I will ask you to identify which book it's from, and why the passage is significant.

Part II: Short answer questions (20 points)

This section will cover several terms and concepts that we discussed in relation to the six novels we have read so far. In this section, I will give you a term and ask you first to define it in one or two sentences and then to give an example.

Terms to study:

- character vs. narrator
- types of narrative point of view
- flashback vs. foreshadowing
- retrospective narration

Part III: Mini-essay (50 points)

In this section I will ask you to write a short essay on a topic that will cover only the last two books: *One Flew over the Cuckoo's Nest* and *To Kill a Mockingbird*. Since you don't have time to use quotations from the books, you will be asked to write the essay from your memory. However, you can bring these two books to class to consult.

- You are not allowed to bring the earlier books to class.

IMPORTANT: Unless you have a legitimate reason that you can officially prove, you cannot make up for the exam if you miss it. So, be there on time.
