

Common Misconceptions

However, that does not mean the core beliefs were not mentioned. <p>Heresies to avoid:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Arianism: Belief that Jesus is less than the Father Modalism: Belief that the three persons are just three modes Tri-theism: Belief in three gods
Catholic Belief
<p>-The Trinity is described as three persons, with one nature.</p> <p>-Called a mystery of the Faith, as we can say what it means but we cannot say how it is true.</p> <p>-All 3 are co-eternal, co-equal and possess all the Divine Attributes (omniscience, omnipresence, immutability)</p> <p>-Any mission of God is performed by all 3 persons with the exception of the Incarnation.</p>
