

Common Misconceptions

• The Trinity never as an explicit concept in the Bible. However, that does not mean the core beliefs were not mentioned.

Heresies to avoid:

- Arianism: Belief that Jesus is less than the Father
- Modalism: Belief that the three persons are just three modes
- Tri-theism: Belief in three gods

Catholic Belief

- -The Trinity is described as three persons, with one nature.
- -Called a mystery of the Faith, as we can say what it means but we cannot say how it is true.
- -All 3 are co-eternal, co-equal and possess all the Divine Attributes (omniscience, omnipresence, immutability)
- -Any mission of God is performed by all 3 persons with the exception of the Incarnation.
