



**Registration for the 7th Annual Bucket 100 Bicycle Tour
Presented by Purdue University Habitat for Humanity
October 27th and 28th, 2012**

The Bucket 100 is an annual weekend bicycle tour through Central Indiana. It was created in 2006 to raise money and awareness for the mission of Habitat for Humanity in the state, as well as establish community between the campus chapters at Indiana University and Purdue University.

Six years later the goals are largely the same, although many people who ride on the "Bucket" have no previous affiliation with Habitat. Riders range in skill level, from novices to experienced cyclists. Training information and rides will be established and will provide riders with the knowledge and skills to have a safe, enjoyable ride.

Riders will be bused down to Indiana University on the morning of Saturday, October 27th. That morning they will depart IU for a two day, 120 mile journey that will culminate at Purdue on October 28th. Along the way, the group will overnight in a school in Danville, riding 60 miles per day. Habitat will provide breakfast and dinner on Saturday as well as breakfast on Sunday. Cyclists will be supported by two Support and Gear (SAG) vans that will be available to provide first aid, assistance with flat tires and minor mechanical issues, refreshments, water, etc. Their overnight belongings will also be transported in a SAG van. A one-day, 120 mile option is available this year on Saturday, October 27th (more details to come).

Each cyclist is required to pay a \$30 registration fee as well as raise at least \$100 of support for his or her campus chapter build. The \$30 fee provides meals over the weekend as well as a t-shirt. If you are in need of a bicycle, Habitat will provide one on a first come, first served basis for the duration of training and the event for a fee of \$40. \$20 will be reimbursed after the bicycle has been returned with normal wear and tear. The other \$20 will be used for repair and maintenance on the bike.

PLEASE READ AND SIGN THIS RELEASE TO BE OFFICIALLY REGISTERED. I do hereby freely acknowledge and realize the dangers of participating in the 2012 Bucket 100 Bicycle Tour presented by Lafayette Habitat for Humanity. ("Habitat"). I fully assume all risks, including, without limitation, collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders, sponsors, promoters or drivers which may be the result of my actions; and furthermore, assume all risks associated with dangers arising from falls, road surfaces, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, weather conditions, as well as the possibility of physical and/or fixed or moving objects, as well as the possibility of physical and/or mental trauma or injury. I understand that the route requires bicycling on public roads and in bad weather and that cyclists have been injured, hospitalized and even killed because of traffic mishaps that are either their responsibility or others' responsibility, and I further agree that I release Habitat for Humanity of Indiana from expenses incurred in any such accidents.

I realize that the Event requires physical conditioning, and I represent that I am in sound medical condition. I have no physical or medical impediment which would endanger me or others. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during the Event which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters or organizers of the Event, including Habitat, and agree to ride so as not to endanger myself or others. I also agree to allow Habitat for humanity of Indiana to seek out emergency medical care on my behalf if I am injured or incapacitated for any reason.

I waive, release and discharge, for myself and my heirs executors, administrators, personal representatives and successors, any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may hereafter accrue to me against Habitat for Humanity and any other sponsors or promoters of the Event, and their respective officers, directors, members, shareholders, employees, and other agents (the "Releases"), for any and all damages, injuries or claims which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly arising out of my participation in the Event and which may occur either prior to or after the Event. The foregoing waiver and release shall include any damage or loss to my person or property which may be caused by any act on my part which is unsafe, unreasonable, or not in compliance with the safety guidelines set forth for the 2012 Bucket 100 Bicycle Tour.

I agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless each Release from and against any expense, cost, loss, liability, damage, or other obligation, including, without limitation, any attorney fees, whether arising from any underlying obligation or in the enforcement of this indemnification obligation, arising from or relating in any manner to my participation in the Event or my breach of this agreement.

I give my permission to Habitat to use my name, address, voice and likeness, including any photograph, videotape, motion picture, digital picture or recording, other recording, Habitat articles, evaluations or any other written or oral record or my participation in the Event for any publicity and or promotional purpose of Habitat without obligation or liability to me, and I further waive any rights of privacy or publicity that I may have in connection with such uses.

I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle or other equipment. I will carry personal identification on me at all times throughout the Event and will abide by all rules and regulations of Habitat relating to the Event. The above representations, acknowledgements, understandings, undertakings and agreements are my express understanding of the risks associated with my participation in the Event and I assume these risks voluntarily and freely without any coercion or duress.

I do certify that I am at least 16 years of age. If I am age 18 or younger, but older than 16, my parent or guardian is also signing this release and agreement on my behalf and each such signatory agrees to be bound by the terms of this agreement.

The laws of the State of Indiana shall govern any disputes or other matters relating to this release and agreement.
