# Doctoral Study Milestones

- Meet with your advisor each semester
  - Discuss progress and register for classes
- Plan of Study
  - Listing of all course work for the degree
  - Must be approved by a committee of at least 3 graduate faculty members
- Completion of Course Work
  - Complete courses on Plan of Study



# Doctoral Study Milestones, cont'd.

- Preliminary Examination
  - Assessment of learning and readiness for dissertation completed near the end of course work
  - Involves written and oral components that often span a semester or more
- Dissertation Proposal
  - Formal proposal of proposed dissertation work
  - Presented to and approved by committee



# Doctoral Study Milestones, cont'd.

- Dissertation Work
  - Completion of dissertation research under direction of major professor
- Final Defense
  - Formal presentation and defense of dissertation
  - Approved by committee of at least 4
- Thesis Deposit
  - Completion and formal submission of dissertation
